Application Deadlines	March 26 Students submit ALL the Application materials to HU	
Certificate of Eligibility (CoE) to obtain Student Visa	<ul> <li>After the notification of admission, HU will assist the students to obtain 'Certificate of Eligibility' (CoE).</li> <li>Please be reminded that the CoE application will become invalid if students apply for CoE individually.</li> </ul>
